2011 Golden Spike Chardonnay Clare Valley

The 'golden spike' (GSSP) is the international geological reference point for the Ediacaran period in our own Flinders Ranges. We support the South Australia Museum's Sprigg Lecture Series, celebrating the discovery by Dr Reg Sprigg OA of the world's oldest fossils.

We sourced the fruit for this single vineyard Chardonnay from an older low cropping vineyard in the heart of the Clare Valley. It was harvested at the end of February when the fruit flavours were at perfect ripeness.

An unwooded Chardonnay style, this wine displays aromas of white peach, citrus blossom and pineapple. The palate is mouth filling with a crisp but creamy texture balanced with flavours of grapefruit, apricot and nectarine. A small portion (17%) of the free run juice was barrel fermented in new French oak for twelve weeks to enhance the texture on the palate. The wine has a long, fresh and clean finish.
